

The University of Illinois Springfield invites applications for a three year (9-month appointment) with the possibility for renewal in the Department of Communication beginning August 16, 2021. This position will be housed in the Department of Communication, but will also work closely with the Management, Marketing and Operations housed in the College of Business and Management. UIS faculty are expected to be available and engaged in the campus community to perform professional responsibilities as assigned. Opportunities to teach additional courses in the summer may be available.

QUALIFICATIONS: Requirements for this position include a minimum of a M.A. in Communication from an accredited university, two years of excellence in teaching experience at the university level. PhD and/or industry experience, and experience teaching in an online/blended format are preferred. Ability and/or willingness to teach organizational communication, public relations and/or gender communication is highly desired, in addition to managerial communication. UIS is an affirmative action/equal opportunity employer.
