- Thirty additional hours of graduate study in the field is required for tenure
- Must be an accomplished teacher and performer with demonstrable success working with undergraduate students
- Demonstrable success with graduate students desired
- An engaging teaching manner and outstanding interpersonal skills for student recruitment are essential
- Demonstrated commitment to diversity and experience with promoting inclusive excellence is required
