Duties: Clinical faculty will teach courses in health policy, healthcare/public health law and ethics, and public health leadership and evaluation; engage in research in these areas; and initiate and carry out public health practice activities with community partners.

Qualifications: Candidates for this position must have a research focus on health policy, healthcare law and ethics, or public health leadership and evaluation and must have a terminal degree in law, policy, public health, or a closely related discipline. A strong record of teaching, publication and experience with extramurally funded research grants is expected commensurate with stage of career.

Evaluation of applications will be ongoing until the position is filled, but preference will be given to those received before July 10, 2019.
