Subfields open; ability to teach public history courses preferred. The successful candidate will teach the US-survey as well as upper-division and MA courses in their field(s) of specialization. The candidate must demonstrate potential for research and service, a commitment to diversity, and experience promoting inclusive excellence. The candidate may be expected to teach online as needed, with requisite training provided by the university if necessary. PhD preferred, ABD considered if degree is expected by date of appointment on August 16, 2020.
