Tenure Track in
School of Technology Graduate Programs

The School of Technology at Eastern Illinois University invites applications for a tenure track instructor position starting in August 2022, subject to available funding. A doctoral degree in a Technology field or a closely-related field and University teaching experience are required, with preference to applicants who have industrial or teaching experience. Commitment to diversity and inclusive excellence is required.

Enrolling more than 8,600 students, Eastern Illinois University is a regional comprehensive institution offering a diverse array of undergraduate degree programs and more than 30 graduate degree programs, as well as ten post-baccalaureate certificate programs. Eastern has consistently been recognized by U.S. News & World Report as a top regional comprehensive residential campus in Illinois and prepares more undergraduates who go on to earn doctoral degrees than any other master's college/university in Illinois, according to a recent National Science Foundation survey. In addition to ranking first in the state, the NSF surveys rank EIU in the top 5 percent nationwide.

The School of Technology has undergraduate programs in Computer and Information Technology, Organizational Development, Digital Media, Construction Management, and Engineering Technology. There are also three graduate programs: Technology, Cybersecurity, and Talent Development. This faculty will be appointed as a member in the School of Technology, which seeks a highly-motivated team player to assist the growth of these programs.

The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching graduate courses and support one or more of the undergraduate fields. A typical workload per semester will include 3-4 courses in classroom/laboratory. In addition, mentoring undergraduate and graduate students in research and contributing to the accreditation process are expected.

Review of applications will begin on March 21, 2022 and will continue until the position is filled. Applicants must submit a letter of application (cover letter), statement of teaching philosophy, curriculum vitae, undergraduate and graduate transcripts, and names of three references (with whom you have collaborated with in the last 5 years) with contact information to Interfolio at <http://apply.interfolio.com/103656>.
