The Department of World Languages & Cultures at Eastern Illinois University is seeking a full-time Spanish Instructor for an annually contracted position (ACF).

**Responsibilities:** The instructor is responsible for teaching Spanish language courses (primarily introductory-level classes). Teach upper-level course as needed (possibly Methods course for teacher licensure students in World Languages). Willingness to supervise extracurricular activities, mentor undergraduate students in high-impact learning experiences, and participate in the recruitment of majors and minors is desirable. Standard teaching load is three classes per semester.

**Qualifications:** PhD in Spanish strongly preferred, with proven teaching experience at the undergraduate level. Master's degree in Spanish will be considered. Native or near-native fluency in Spanish required. Ability to teach Methods course for teacher licensure students desirable. We are especially interested in candidates with a dynamic teaching style and ability to implement a learner-centered pedagogy in an inclusive classroom. Demonstrated commitment to diversity and experience with promoting inclusivity required.
