Assistant Professor Position Announcement

The Department of Counseling and Higher Education invites applications for a full-time tenure-track faculty position for a nine-month appointment with possible summer teaching. The department is a CACREP accredited, student-centered program with collaborative faculty meetings. Responsibilities include teaching in the following areas: Basic Skills, Practicum, Diagnosis and Treatment Planning (DSM-5), and Cross Cultural Counseling.

Qualifications:

Candidate must have a doctorate degree in a CACREP accredited counseling program (or evidence that the doctorate will be completed by July 1, 2020). Preferred qualifications include evidence of effective teaching at the university level, a research agenda through previous lines of inquiry and professional practice with an emphasis on clinical counseling. Individuals should also demonstrate commitment to diversity and experience with promoting inclusive excellence.
