- An engaging teaching manner and outstanding interpersonal skills for student recruitment are essential.
- Demonstrated commitment to diversity and experience promoting inclusive excellence is required.

Preferred Qualifications: Preference will be given to candidates with 4 or more years of teaching undergraduates, 2 years teaching graduate students.
