**Electrical Engineering Program Position Announcement**  
**9 Month, Non-Tenure Track in Electrical Engineering**

The Electrical Engineering Program at Eastern Illinois University invites applications for a non-tenure track instructor position in Electrical Engineering starting in August 2022, subject to available funding. A minimum of master's degree in Electrical Engineering or Computer Engineering and full-time engineering work experience are required. Eligibility for a Professional Engineer (PE) credential is strongly preferred, with preference to applicants who already have PE licensure.

Eastern Illinois University (EIU) is a comprehensive state university in a community of 20,000 in east central Illinois. Enrollment at the university is approximately 8,000 and growing. As a primarily undergraduate teaching institution, EIU is dedicated to quality learning in small class settings. Electrical Engineering (EE) is a newly established program within the Physics Department with a collaboration with the School of Technology. This faculty will be appointed as a member in the School of Technology, which seeks a highly motivated candidate to assist the growth of the new EE program.

The successful candidate will be responsible for supervising and coordinating an internship program, maintaining close contacts with industry, and teaching primarily lower-division undergraduate courses in support of the Electrical Engineering program and the School of Technology. A typical teaching load per semester will include teaching 2-4 courses in classroom/laboratory with an expectation for summer internship supervision (compensated according to Collective Bargaining Agreement). In addition, mentoring undergraduate students in engineering-related research, and contributing to the ABET accreditation process are expected. Commitment to diversity and inclusive excellence is required.

Review of applications will begin on January 31, 2022 and will continue until the position is filled. Applicants must submit a letter of application (cover letter), statement of teaching philosophy, curriculum vitae, undergraduate and graduate transcripts, and names of three references with contact information, to Interfolio at <http://apply.interfolio.com/100200>.
