Beyond primary duties in the area of human resources, the position will convene the Plantworx committee (a facilities planning group), develop summer school schedules in consultation with the deans, monitor internal master calendar compliance, and coordinate academic technology project implementation.

Qualifications: Qualified applicants must hold at least a Master's degree with advanced credentials consistent with the tenure requirements in an existing EIU academic unit preferred and have experience with human resource policies and practices; demonstrated familiarity with negotiated labor agreements; and a commitment to inclusive excellence and diversity. Direct supervisory experience in a negotiated higher education setting is required with leadership experience at the level of dean or higher preferred.
